

To All Home State Bank VISA Debit Card Users:

On the weekend of September 18th, Home State Bank / West Iowa Bank will be consolidating our operating systems. This will impact your current debit card and you can expect the following changes:

- In early September, a new West Iowa Bank **Mastercard** debit card will be mailed to you. The new cards will not be will **not** be able to be activated until September 21st once our core consolidation takes place.
- You will need to call West Iowa Bank to get your new PIN set up.
- Your current Home State Bank debit card will work the weekend of September 18th but you will not have access to balance inquiry.
- Beginning September 21st, your Home State Bank VISA debit card will no longer work and you will need to activate your new West Iowa Bank Mastercard for use going forward.
- Any auto-transactions tied to your debit card will need to be changed to your new debit card once it becomes active on September 21st.
